### Day 1: Taipei

**Tour Attractions:** Chiang Kai-Sek Memorial Hall, Shilin Residence, Aboriginal Products Shop, Vigor Kobo, Pingxi, Shihfen, National Martyr's Shrine, Taipei Handicraft Center, Wufenpu and Raohe Night Market

- Have a good breakfast at your respective hotels in Taipei, you will be welcomed by our tour guide at your hotel lobby and brought on your tour.



- ✓ First up, you will explore the majestic **Chiang Kai-Sek Memorial Hall**; named after the former president of Republic of China (Taiwan). The Memorial was mooted as an idea after Chiang Kai-Sek passed on in 1975; it was successfully completed in 1980. In the main hall, come face to face with a **huge bronze statue** of Chiang Kai-Sek where locals come to pay their respects. Learn more about his life stories from the exhibits on display and don't miss the **honor guard shift-changing ceremony** that happens at the top of every hour on level 4!

- ✓ Following, you will visit **Shilin Residence**, the former residence of Chiang Kak-Shek and his wife. The residence boasts of its intricate flora and fauna; visit the Victoria Chapel as well
- ✓ Next, you will visit a **Aboriginal Products Shop** where you can purchase unique products
- ✓ Time to stock-up on gifts as you visit **Vigor Kobo** – a renowned bakery in Taipei. You must try their signature Pineapple Cake or “Fengli Su” made with the freshest pineapple fillings covered with a light and crisp pastry. All their pastries come in lovely gift boxes which make these pastries the perfect gift for loved ones.
- ✓ You will also visit the beautiful and culturally-rich towns of Shihfen and Pingxi. In **Pingxi**, check out the **Old Street** which was built into a hill with a train track going overhead the marketplace. Check out old shops built all the way back in the 1930s – 1940s.  
In **Shihfen**, visit the 20 meters tall **Shihfen Waterfall**, regarded as one of the most beautiful in Taiwan. If you are lucky, you may even see a rainbow as the water splashes into the lake. Next visit **Shihfen Old Street** where an unusual local train station sits, the train runs straight through the middle of a marketplace, a peculiar sight. The tracks and trains were once part of a once booming coal-mining industry in Taiwan.
- ✓ Visit the **National Martyr's Shrine**. The Shrine is dedicated to the 390,000 soldiers who perished during the War of Resistance against Japan and the civil war between Chinese Republican and Communist Forces.
- ✓ Subsequently, visit the **Taipei Handicraft Center** and be awe-struck by the extensive display of traditional handicraft. This is the best time to buy an authentic gift for a friend back home.
- ✓ Time for shopping! Visit the largest garment market in Taiwan, **Wufenpu**, and be amazed by trendy fashion clothing at affordable prices.
- ✓ Finally, the **Raohe Night Market** encompasses the essence of a Taiwanese traditional night market. Being one of the oldest night markets in Taiwan, you will find quaint shops, carnival games and authentic local cuisine. It is an amazing atmosphere not to be missed.
