5 Days 4 Nights Perth Extravaganza Tour

Day 01 PERTH ARRIVAL

Upon arrival at the Perth Airport, transfer to your hotel for check in and get some well-deserved rest.

Day 02 PERTH CITY – FREMANTLE TOUR **(B)**

Begin your day after breakfast at the beautiful **Kings Park botanical gardens**, whilst here you will have time to experience a walk through the tree's canopies on the **Tree Top Walkway**. Later, we continue to one of Perth's best beaches **Cottesloe Beach** before arriving at the historic port town of **Fremantle**. Part with the group here if you wish to explore other famous attractions. Return to Perth by road travelling past Perth's most exclusive suburbs, the **University of Western Australia**, **Royal Perth Yacht Club**, the **Old Swan Brewery**, **Barrack Street Jetty**, the famous **Bell Tower** and finally the **Perth Mint**. Optional afternoon half day swan valet, wildlife, chocolate and wine tour. (Departs Weds, Fri, Sun)

Day 03 ONE CHOICE OF FULL DAY TOUR **(B)**

4WD Sand dune/sand boarding/koalas/pinnacles (Daily Departure)

Morning, head to **Caversham Wildlife Park** in the Swan Valley to view koalas and hand feed kangaroos, lobster fishing town of Cervantes for lunch. Stop at the **Lobster Shack** for an informative talk about the lobster industry, followed by a self-guided tour through the purpose built factory. Then it's onwards to the mystical **Pinnacles Desert** for an easy paced walk through the fascinating landscape where you will be in awe at the sheer size and number of these spires. Afterwards enjoy a thrilling experience of **Sand Boarding** and **4-Wheel driving** over the vast sand dunes of Lancelin.

Wave rock, York, Wildflowers & Aboriginal Culture (Departs Tue, Weds, Fri, Sun)

Enjoy some morning tea (own expense) at **Historic York**, the first township founded in the Avon Valley. Visit the Dog Cemetery before arriving in **Hyden**. Then visit **Hippo's Yawn**, a rock formation which resembles a hippo yawning. Break for a buffet lunch at the Wildflower Shop. See the spectacle of **Wave Rock** and the ancient **Gnamma Holes**. Whilst here visit either a **Wildlife Park** or view the unique **Antique Lace Collection**. Leaving Wave Rock we visit **The Humps and Mulka's Cave**. Return to Perth via a different route and stop at the quaint country town of **Babakin** for afternoon tea prepared by the Country Women's Association (own expense). Wildflower viewing stops are made in season.

Margaret River, Cave, Wine, Busselton Jetty (Departs Mon, Tue, Thu, Fri, Sat)
