## • 4 DAYS 3 NIGHTS 3 ROUNDS SAIGON & VUNG TAU GOLF • (BACCARAT PACKAGE)

### Day 1 : Arrival in Saigon

Upon arrival, your tour guide will escorts you to the transport for your transfer to **Twin Doves Golf Club** for your first golf game. With three distinctly different nines, the Luna Course is scenic with numerous small hills bordered by forest, and incorporates all the natural elements as challenging hazards. Nature's best continues to feature in the exciting Stella Course, as creeks weave between tree-flanked holes, requiring accurate shot making to multi-tiered greens guarded by water hazards. Playing around a lake is the Sole Course, replete with an island green, beach bunkers, and of course a series of water hazards.



### Day 2 : Saigon - Vung Tau (Breakfast)



It's golf today at **Long Thanh Golf Club**. Both the immaculate Hill and Coral courses feature rolling fairways and large undulating greens, with many high lipped bunkers and water hazards on almost every hole to catch errant shots. The short rough at Long Thanh poses no real problems, though higher handicappers might prefer the relatively flatter Lake Course. The signature par 3, 4<sup>th</sup> hole on the Hill Course has a choice of two different greens, both of

which require accurate tee shots, to avoid the OB stakes at the back of the longer green; and also the 'Great Wall of Long Thanh' that surrounds the even more difficult shorter green also guarded by water in the front and a rock face behind. After golf, transfer to Vung Tau (about one hour) and check into your hotel for a night's stay.

### Day 3 : Vung Tau – Saigon (Breakfast)

It's links-style golf at **The Bluffs Ho Tram Strip**. Set on the coastline, holes are routed over and around towering sand dunes, and strong sea winds which change direction are always a factor, playing havoc and challenging even the best seasoned golfers. One of the most spectacular spots, the signature 4<sup>th</sup> hole treats players to a spectacular 360 degree view of the course, the surrounding forest and wildlife, the expansive Vietnam coast, and the Grand Ho Tram Strip integrated resort. "This is a very fair and playable golf course, but to shoot a good score, you're going to need a well-rounded game," said course designer Greg Norman. After golf, it's a two hour transfer back into Saigon for a one night stay.



### Day 4 : Departure from Saigon (Breakfast)

At the scheduled time, transfer to the airport for your homebound flight.
