* 3 Days 2 Nights Siem Reap + Angkor Wat Tour * (Daisy Package)

Day 1: Arrival to Siem Reap (Lunch, Dinner)

Upon arrival to Siem Reap, you will be welcomed by our tour guide at the airport and transferred to hotel for 2 nights' stay.

- ❖ Begin your tour in Siem Reap with a boat trip on the **Tonle Sap Lake** to visit the rustic Floating Village.
- ❖ Afterwards, head to the **Les Artisan D' Angkor (Art School)**, an educational center that trains rural young people in traditional skills of stone carving, wood carving, lacquer and silk weaving.
- ❖ After lunch, proceed to **Angkor Silk Farm** to understand the fascinating process of silk-making and buy high-quality silk products. You will also tour a **Local Market** to check out the local items being sold.
- ❖ Tonight, you will enjoy dinner with an **Aspara Dance Performance** before returning to hotel to rest.



Day 2: Siem Reap (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Today, you will embark on a tour to discover the spectacular Angkor Thom and Angkor Wat regions.

- ❖ Start the day with a visit to the Angkor Thom area via the **South Gate of Angkor Thom**. Inside the walls of this city, you will tour **Bayon**, standing in the exact centre of Angkor Thom. Located 200m northwest of the Bayon is the **Baphuon**, a single sanctuary temple-mountain situated on a high base. Then, visit the **Phimean Akas Temple**, enclosed by the walls of the Royal Palace. The temple is built of roughly hewn sandstone blocks and has little decoration. Next, proceed to the **Elephants Terrace**, dedicated to Buddhist and replica to the Bayon style of art. Afterwards, head to the **Leper King Terrace**, faced with dramatic bas-reliefs, and carries on the grandeur theme that characterizes the building during Jayavarman VII's reign. You will also tour the **Royal Palace, Woman and Man Pond**, enclosed by a laterite wall with only the base remaining today.



- ❖ Next, visit the UNESCO World Heritage Site – **Ta-Prohm Temple**. The photogenic and atmospheric combination of trees growing out of the ruins and the jungle surroundings have made the site one of Angkor's most visited temples.

- ❖ After lunch, continue your journey to the largest religious monument in the world – the

Angkor Wat. Built in the early 12th century, this architectural masterpiece is one of the seven greatest architectural wonders of the world.

- ❖ Lastly, make a visit to **Phnom Bakheng** for its beautiful sunset.
- ❖ Transfer to your hotel thereafter for a good night's rest.



Day 3: Departure from Siem Reap (Breakfast)

Free till departure transfer to airport for homebound flight.
