* 5D4N Siem Reap + Phnom Penh X 2D Tour * (Bauhinia Package)

Day 1: Arrival to Siem Reap (Lunch, Dinner)

Upon arrival to Siem Reap, you will be welcomed by our tour guide at the airport and brought on the tour.

- ❖ First, proceed to the **Angkor Silk Farm** to understand the fascinating process of silk-making and buy high-quality silk products.
- ❖ Next, visit the floating village of **Chong Khneas**, located 10 km south of Siem Reap.
- ❖ Following, take a traditional wooden boat ride on the **Tonle Sap Lake**, the Great Lake of Cambodia.
- ❖ Next, visit the **Les Artisan D' Angkor (Chantiers Ecoles)** – an educational center that trains rural young people in traditional skills of stone carving, wood carving, lacquer and silk weaving.
- ❖ Time to explore the **Local Market** at your own leisure.
- ❖ Lastly, enjoy dinner with an **Aspara Dancing Performance** before you return to hotel for the night.



Day 2: Siem Reap (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Today, you will embark on a tour to discover the spectacular Angkor Thom and Angkor Wat regions.

- ❖ Start the day with a visit to the Angkor Thom area via the **South Gate of Angkor Thom**. Inside the walls of this city, you will tour **Bayon**, standing in the exact center of the city of Angkor Thom. Located 200m northwest of the Bayon is the **Baphuon**, a single sanctuary temple-mountain situated on a high base. Then, visit the **Phimean Akas Temple**, built of roughly hewn sandstone blocks and has little decoration. Next, proceed to the **Elephants Terrace**, dedicated to Buddhist and replica to the Bayon style of art. Afterwards, head to the **Leper King Terrace**, faced with dramatic bas-reliefs, and carries on the grandeur theme that characterizes the building during Jayavarman VII's reign. You will also tour the **Royal Palace, Woman and Man Pond**, enclosed by a laterite wall with only the base remaining today.



- ❖ Following, visit the **Ta-Prohm Temple**. The photogenic and atmospheric combination of trees growing out of the ruins and the jungle surroundings have made the UNESCO World Heritage Site one of Angkor's most visited temples.
- ❖ After lunch, continue your journey to the largest religious monument in the world – the **Angkor Wat Temple**. This architectural masterpiece is one of

the seven greatest architectural wonders of the world.

- ❖ Lastly, make a visit to **Phnom Bakheng** to view its beautiful sunset.
- ❖ Transfer back to hotel after dinner for a good night's rest.

Day 3: Siem Reap – Phnom Penh (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

This morning, you will take the public coach to transfer to Phnom Penh – the capital city of Cambodia. Upon arrival to Phnom Penh, enjoy your lunch then check in to hotel.

❖ First, visit the **National Museum**, also called Musee des Beaux-Arts. It contains a collection of Khmer architecture and sculptures since the ancient times.



❖ Following, proceed to the **Royal Palace**, built by King Norodom in 1866 on the site of the old town. On the south side of the palace is the **Silver Pagoda**, which got its name because its floor is made up of 5,000 silver tiles.

❖ Next, visit the tallest religious structure in the city – the **Wat Phnom**. It is a Buddhist temple built in 1373. At 27m above ground, you can enjoy stunning views over the tree-lined avenues of the city.

❖ Thereafter, head to the **Independence Monument** built in 1958 for Cambodia's independence from France in 1953. It stands on the intersection of Norodom Boulevard and Sihanouk Boulevard in the center of the city.

❖ Following, enjoy a leisurely stroll along **Sisowath Quay**, which runs along the west bank of the Tonle Sap River. This is a 3km strip lined with hotels, restaurants, bars, cafes and shops.

❖ You can also try your luck at the well-known **NAGA World Casino** before returning to hotel to rest.

Day 4: Phnom Penh (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



❖ Start your day with a visit to the notorious **Tuol Sleng Museum**. In 1975 Tuol Svay Prey High School, the former site of the museum, was taken over by Pol Pot's security forces and turned into a prison known as Security Prison 21 (S-21).

❖ Thereafter, visit the **Killing Fields of Choeung EK**, about 17km south of Phnom Penh. It used to be the site of a former orchard and mass grave of victims of the Khmer Rouge killed between 1975 and 1979.

❖ After lunch, you will tour the **Russian Market (Psah Tuol Thom Pong)**, a lively outdoor market where you will find a large selection of souvenirs, curios, antiques, handicraft, and many other things of interest to visitors. It is also the place to buy clothes at big discount prices.

❖ Return to your hotel after dinner to rest for the night.



Day 5: Departure from Phnom Penh (Breakfast)

Free till departure transfer to airport for homebound flight.
