### Day 1: Arrival to Seoul – Gangwon (Lunch, Dinner)

#### Scenic Gangwon Tour



Annyeong Haseyo! Upon arrival at Incheon airport, you will be welcomed by our tour guide at the airport and brought on the tour at Gangwon. Your first stop will be at **Mount Sorak National Park** which is designated a Biosphere Preservation District by UNESCO in 1982. Take the cable car which will bring you near the top of the mountain and visit the castle ruins site

**Gwongeumseong Fortress, Sinheungsa temple and the Big Bronze Buddha.** After dinner, check in to hotel in Gangwon for a good night's rest.



### Day 2: Gangwon – Nami Island – Seoul (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

#### Relaxation Tour



Check out of hotel after breakfast and start your day with a visit to the **Nami Island**, where many scenes in the famous Korean drama "Winter Sonata" were filmed. Recreate the romantic Winter Sonata scenes as the main leads Jun-sang and Yu-jin in this hugely popular TV drama while you visit the actual beautiful filming spots on the island! Next, proceed to **Edelweiss Swiss Theme Park** to enjoy Switzerland architecture, experience programs, trick art and its natural scenery. After dinner, check in to hotel in Seoul for 3-night

stay.



### Day 3: Seoul (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



#### City Highlights Tour

After breakfast, you will visit the majestic **Gyeongbokgung Palace**, the largest and arguably most beautiful of the five grand palaces built by the Joseon Dynasty in 1395. Then, proceed to the **National Folk Museum** within the Gyeongbokgung Palace compounds, where you will be able to learn more about Korea's traditional lifestyle and cultural beliefs. Thereafter, get ready your cameras as we drive past the **Presidential Blue House**, the presidential residence and heart of the nation of Korea. Following, head to the **Namsangol Hanok Village**, a restored traditional Korean village in the city's central district. Thereafter, visit **N Seoul Tower**, a major tourist attraction sitting atop Namsan Mountain to enjoy a stunning panoramic view of Seoul and its surrounding areas. Next, enjoy bargain shopping at the **Ginseng Showroom and Amethyst Outlet**. Shop to your heart's content at the famous **Myeongdong Fashion Street**. Finally, return to hotel to rest for the night.

### Day 4: Seoul (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

#### Cultural and Shopping Tour



After breakfast in hotel, head to the **Odusan Unification Observatory**, one of the national tourist spots where you can experience the stark reality of the divided Peninsula and purchase products from North Korea. Next, visit the themed **Provence Village** with lovely cafes, restaurants, bakeries and craft shops. Thereafter, proceed to the cultural art town of **Heyri Village** with many art museums and galleries. Following, visit the **Cosmetic Shop** and **Duty Free Shop** to enjoy free make-up lessons and purchase beauty products at attractive prices. Then, it is time for **Dongdaemun Design Plaza** where you can find a mix of traditional buildings and relics such as the Seoul Fortress, as well as modern multicultural facilities such as the Design Gallery and Event Hall. You can also shop to your heart's content at the **Dongdaemun Market** before returning to the hotel for well-deserved rest.



### Day 5: Departure from Seoul (Breakfast, Lunch)

#### Heritage Tour



After breakfast, visit **Jogae Temple** and **Insadong Cultural Street**, where you can experience traditional Korean culture and purchase pieces of fine art. Thereafter, visit **Bukchon Hanok Village**, home to hundreds of traditional houses called 'hanok' that date back to the Joseon Dynasty. You will also visit **Samcheongdong Gil** in the area, a peaceful and quaint area lined with cafes, museums and art galleries. Finally, it is time for last minute shopping at the **Souvenir Shop** before you transfer to the airport for your homebound flight.
